

Call for nominations for the DWU Teaching Excellence Awards 2025

The following criteria, which draw on the literature on good teaching (Hammer et al., 2010) are used.

The nominated lecturer

- Teaches in ways that inspire and engage students and helps students to become lifelong learners;
- Assists students in and out of lecture room/laboratory;
- Provides good prompt assessment and constructive feedback to students;
- Is fair and respects student differences;
- Makes good use of online opportunities and provides up-to-date resources;
- Is supportive and works well with academic colleagues
- Demonstrates a commitment to teaching an willingness to be called on if needed;
- Demonstrates an understanding of the scholarship of teaching and learning

Any DWU academic staff member who teaches at least two units a year in any mode of study (full-time, flexible learning or online), on or through any campus, can be nominated.

DWU President and Vice Presidents are not eligible for nomination.

A group of at least three students must nominate the lecturer.

The lecturer must agree to the nomination.

The nominations closing date is Friday, 24th October 2025.
